The Fleur de Lis Republican Women's Scholarship applications will be collected using a Google Documents platform. Once the application period has closed, a member of the Fleur de Lis Republican Women's board will be responsible for creating a google sheet with each applicant and the answer to the questions, ensuring that the students' names are not found on any of the answers. The file will be sent to the Scholarship Committee Readers to read each applicant's answers and score each question based on character, leadership, Republican values, academics, and volunteerism. All questions will receive the same weight.

Two \$1000 scholarships will be awarded. Recipients will be announced in April with an invitation to attend the May Fleur De Lis Republican Women's monthly club meeting.

Eligibility

You must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. The student must reside in and attend one of our Acadiana area high schools the same year the scholarship is awarded.
- 2. The student must be related to or sponsored by a Fleur de Lis Republican Club member who has an ACTIVE club membership status, which means they are not an active member of another Louisiana Federation of Republican Women Club.
- 3. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited 4-year degree granting institution or a 2-year technical college in Louisiana. Award winners must verify registration before receiving scholarship.
